Quarterback Club Commitment Frequently Asked Questions

Is my contribution tax deductible?

Yes, gifts to Intercollegiate Athletics and Penn State are recognized by the Internal Revenue Service as charitable contributions. A full deduction may be taken when no tangible benefits are received for the gift. Benefits, such as tickets and priority points are 80% deductible under IRS regulations. *Please consult your tax advisor for detailed information.*

My company has a matching gift program. What do I need to do to ensure their match is applied to my contribution?

Will I receive Nittany Lion Club points for my Quarterback Club Commitment contribution?

Yes, 2 points for every \$100 will be applied to your Nittany Lion Club account.

Do I still need to make a contribution to the Nittany Lion Club/Levi Lamb for my personal account?

Yes, a separate annual gift to the Nittany Lion Club/Levi Lamb fund would still need to be made as it specifically relates to contributions required for tickets, parking and giving level benefits.
